Please Note: Times are approximate and are subject to change. Matches may begin no earlier than 15 minutes from the scheduled starting time. All wrestling will take place in the Convocation Center on the campus of Northern Illinois University.

### **CONSOLATION BRACKET CRITERIA**

- Note 1: Consolation Bracket qualifiers are wrestlers who are beaten by championship bracket wrestlers who advance to the semifinal round.
- Note 2: If consolation bracket qualifiers have wrestled one another in the championship bracket, wrestlers will re-wrestle to determine who advances. There are no walkovers. The loser of the championship bracket semi-final match in the top half of the bracket will be placed in the bottom bracket of the semi-final wrestlebacks while the loser of the semi-final match in the bottom half of the championship bracket will be placed in the top bracket of the semi-final round wrestlebacks.
- Note 3: If a wrestler loses a championship bracket preliminary round bout, and the wrestler who beat him loses in the championship bracket first round, the wrestler losing the championship bracket preliminary round bout will not qualify for the consolation bracket.
- Note 4: If a championship bracket preliminary round bout winner loses his championship bracket first round bout, and the sectional champion wrestler who beats him loses in the championship bracket quarterfinal (next round), the wrestler losing will not qualify for the consolation bracket.

*Individual awards for 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> places will be presented by the coach of each weight class champion following the title bout in each weight class with team awards at conclusion of meet. All wrestlers who place in each weight class are required to report to the awards area following the championship match in their respective weight class for presentation of individual awards to be followed by a group photograph of the place finishers in each weight class. All first-place finishers are to stay in uniform and report following the 65 lb. class individual presentations for a group photograph of all weight class champions. A photographer will be available to photograph each weight class and team champions.*
