

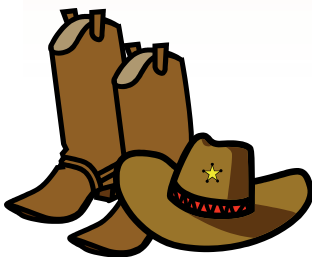


IESA Annual Scholastic Bowl Workshop Information and Registration

I-55 to Exit #167– Veterans Parkway or Business 55 South to Brickyard Drive, Turn Right.

From Springfield:

From Decatur:

I-74 West to Exit 135/or 51 North to Veterans Parkway North/or Business 55 North to Brickyard Drive, Turn Left.
