- The **IESA Has Talent** and boy do we have some for you! Some shining faces are lined up to strut their

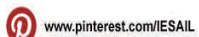
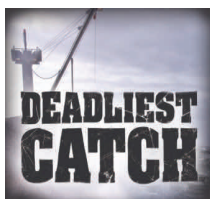
stuff . Demo match run by Jack Small.

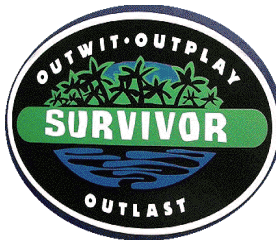

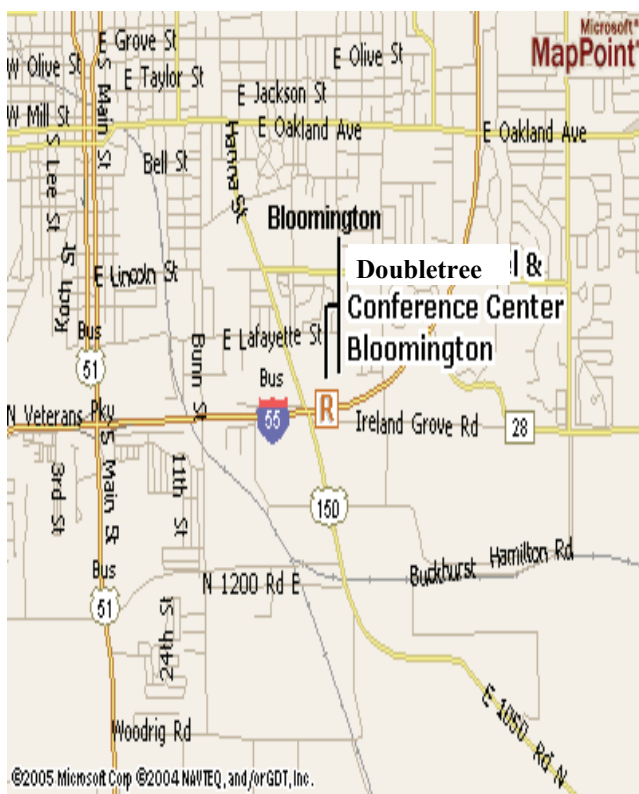
