**Demo Match-** Supreme Leader Jack Small and Princess Like Bonomo provide a demo match with the help of young Jedi's in training.

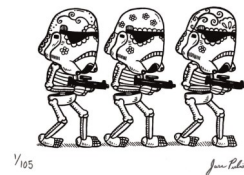
