YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR IESA ACTIVITIES IN 2020-2021:

1. If you are representing a school where you are in attendance in grades five through eight or have been approved for a cooperative team activity.
2. If your birthday is on or after:

September 20, 2004 for Boys and Girls Golf	March 14, 2005 for Boys Wrestling
September 27, 2004 for Girls Softball	March 14, 2006 for 7th Grade Girls Volleyball
October 4, 2004 for Boys Baseball	March 21, 2005 for 8th Grade Girls Volleyball
October 18, 2004 for Boys and Girls Cross-Country	April 18, 2005 for Boys and Girls Bowling
December 11, 2005 for 7th Grade Girls Basketball	May 8, 2005 for Scholastic Bowl
December 18, 2004 for 8th Grade Girls Basketball	May 16, 2006 for 1A & 2A 7th Grade Boys and Girls Track and Field
January 24, 2005 for Cheerleading Competition	May 16, 2005 for 1A & 2A 8th Grade Boys and Girls Track and Field
February 12, 2006 for 7th Grade Boys Basketball	May 23, 2006 for 3A & 4A 7th Grade Boys and Girls Track and Field
February 19, 2005 for 8th Grade Boys Basketball	May 23, 2005 for 3A & 4A 8th Grade Boys and Girls Track and Field
February 28, 2005 for Chess	
3. If you try out only for those activities for which you are eligible by age.
4. If you have provided your principal with a birth certificate or hospital record. A baptismal record is not acceptable.
5. If you have a licensed physician's certificate of physical fitness to participate issued within 395 days preceding your current participation.
6. If you are doing passing work in all of your school subjects.
7. If you have not competed in the same academic grade during a previous school year in the same sport. This is true whether or not you attended a member or non-member school.
8. If you transfer to a different school during the school year, you are eligible to participate for your new school only if you did not participate in a try-out, practice, or game contest with your previous school of attendance in the sport in which you want to compete for your new school. Some schools may not allow transfer students to participate. Please check with your school principal to determine your eligibility if you transfer.
9. Please contact your school principal to determine your eligibility to participate on a non-school team in a sport during the IESA season for the sport.

NOTE: IESA By Laws are published in the official handbook. Your principal should be contacted to check with the Executive Director on any questions you may have concerning your eligibility. There are minor exceptions to the above regulations, which may need further clarification.
