

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DIVISION MEETINGS

Each school will be required to attend a division meeting every fall.

The meetings will highlight new information such as by-law changes and other updates that impact each member school. Additionally, the meetings will provide members schools with the opportunity to meet the IESA staff and their board division representative. Every member school is required to attend a meeting each year. If a school does not attend, the following will be enforced:

By-law 1.041 continued: Failure to comply with this requirement will result in probation for one year. The second consecutive violation will result in a suspension from participation in all the state series for a period of one year beginning on January 1 following the school's second consecutive non-compliance with this rule. Feeder schools which do not enter any IESA sponsored activities are exempt from attending the required division meeting.

Meetings will be held throughout the state at various sites and on various dates.

Meeting dates and locations can be found on the IESA website. Please check the website for the date and location that will work best for a representative of your school.

Schools may attend any division meeting scheduled. Additionally, there will be a Division Meeting presented in the IESA session at the Illinois Principals Association (IPA) Conference each fall.

The IESA session for the 2009 IPA Conference will be Tuesday, October 20 at 8:00 a.m. at the Peoria Civic Center.
