



2019 STUDENT LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

The Illinois Elementary School Association will again host the Student Leadership Conference for 7th and 8th grade students on Friday, September 6, 2019. This student-centered conference will be held in conjunction with the IESA Athletic Directors Workshop at the DoubleTree Hotel and Conference Center in Bloomington. The IESA wants to educate member schools' students on elements of being a leader within their schools and using their influence for the benefit of their school and local community.

The goals of the Student Leadership Conference are to:

- support and develop emerging student leaders throughout the state
- connect students with their peers from different geographic locations
- provide focused instruction and activities that will expose students to trending and relevant topics for their age group
- create school-specific action plan to promote sportsmanship and character
- think globally about using interscholastic activities as a tool to expand student leadership

Students will have the opportunity to hear from a keynote speaker and participate in breakout sessions on topics relevant to today's middle school student. Sessions will be finalized by the start of next month after the IESA Sportsmanship advisory committee has held their annual meeting.

While students attend student-specific sessions, the adults will mostly attend the sessions provided at the Athletic Directors workshop. Both the students and the adults will take part in the joint closing session; to end their day, the students and at least one (1) adult from their school will collaborate in a school-specific action planning session.

Interested schools should complete the registration form and submit it with payment by the posted deadline. Schools are permitted to send a maximum of four (4) students, all of whom must be in 7th or 8th grade at the time of the conference. A light breakfast selection and lunch will be provided. If all spots have been filled prior to the deadline, schools will be placed on a waiting list.
